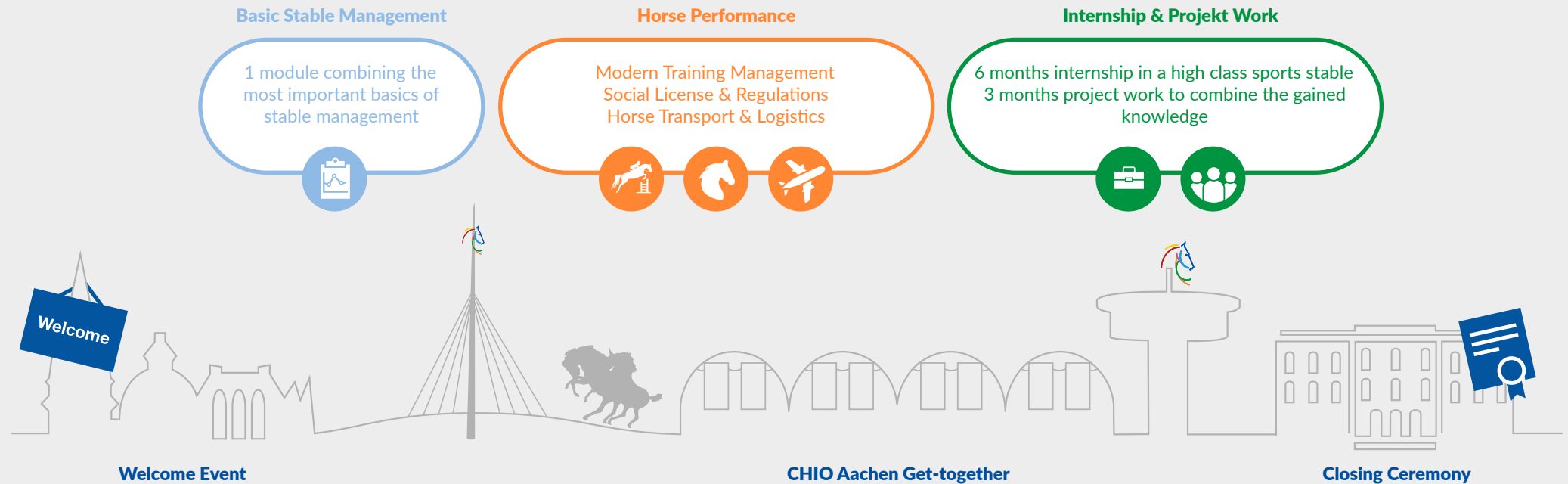
Operative Track

At the same time, the participant networks, makes observations and gathers input for the following project work and final presentation.

Teaching Style

Basic Stable Management

Operative Track Module

This module encompasses the most important principles of business administration that are necessary to be able to successfully accomplish the position of Stable Manager. The new theoretical contents will complement the practical experience you already bring with you on commencing the program. You will occupy yourself with the basic economic correlations and strategic thinking, which will bring your company forward in the equestrian sport. This involves the most important aspects comprising of cost management, process management, digitalization and HR. The learning objective here is for you to learn how to improve the organizational procedures in your equestrian sport business, organize your activities efficiently, calculate investments and make sustainable decisions. You will learn how to combine all of the important aspects so that nothing stands in the way of the success of your equestrian sport business.



Finance Management

Executive Track Module

Finance management is one of the most important factors necessary for being able to run a commercial business successfully and allowing it to grow. This module will specifically teach you how you can maintain the efficiency and competitiveness of your equestrian stable through monitoring, analysis and controlling the costs. You will learn how to handle the budget and will get to know financing models, which have to be taken into consideration for every investment. This will enable you to ensure that resources are used optimally and that any unnecessary expenditure is minimized. You will learn to calculate efficiently, weigh up risks and measure the impact of your investments. Equipped with the fundamental, theoretical knowledge, at the end of the module you will know among other things how to improve your training facilities, acquire a horse trailer or extend stable blocks. In the long run, you will thus be able to realize the long-term goals of your establishment.



Project Management

Executive Track Module

An efficient and well-working project management is a further important aspect that is required for keeping a business running successfully. In this module you will learn how to analyze the operational processes in your equestrian yard accurately so that you can subsequently optimize these, increase the efficiency and performance and in turn reduce the costs. In modern equestrian businesses it is important to retain the overview so any necessary changes to the organizational structure can be made. It is about the identification of bottlenecks, inefficient processes and unfavorable strategies. Processes can be automated through the use of technologies. On completing this module, you will be armed with the knowledge of how you can digitalize the tools of your riding establishment more readily. You will get to know software that will help you keep an eye on the most important data of all horses and automate the recurring processes in your equestrian yard.



Human Resources Management

Executive Track Module

The module teaches you the importance of your role as an employer in your equestrian sport business. Human Resources significantly influences the efficiency and performance of the company. You require a number of skilled workers in your equestrian yard to keep operations running smoothly, including professional riders, trainers, veterinarians, blacksmiths, grooms as well as technical and administrative employees. So, in this module you will occupy yourself with the recruitment of qualified, skilled workers. You will also learn how to promote your employees with training and educational measures to expand their skills and knowledge and satisfy the demands of the business. With the know-how of how to create a good work environment, you will be able to improve the employee motivation and satisfaction. Furthermore, you will learn which work-related and safety regulations you have to observe to ensure the health and safety of your employees.



Modern Training Management

Operative Track & Executive Track Module

International sport horses are top athletes. Important scientific training diagnostics and the vital signs should be taken into consideration when drawing up a health-preserving and performance-promoting training schedule. By understanding the veterinary basics, the metabolism of the horse and the influence of the horse's feeding plan, you will be able to bring your horses into top form. With the aid of manual and digital tools you will be able to provide and improve training and season planning for individual horses.



Social License & Regulations

Operative Track & Executive Track Module

The equestrian sport is built on a partnership-like relationship between the horse and rider. Unfortunately, the equestrian world is overshadowed by current scandals and concerns about animal welfare. As an Equestrian Stable Manager, you are partly responsible for the ongoing acceptance of the horse industry's standards by the general public.

The basic principles of equine welfare and the justification of the equestrian sport is addressed and discussed here. You will furthermore learn the important veterinarian regulations that apply for national and international shows, so you can optimally care for your horses and avoid doping.



Horse Transport & Logistic

Operative Track & Executive Track Module

Over the past decades the international equestrian sport has expanded strongly. Consequently, the show calendars of professional riders include shows all over the globe. As a result, the horses also travel and are transported increasingly. Learn the relevant processes and regulations that apply for the national, international, and intercontinental transport of horses (road, ship, airplane): From the vital signs and red flags of the horses during transport, to the border and customs regulations, through to the quarantine and import regulations.



Marketing & Branding

Executive Track Module

The way you present your equestrian barn to the outside significantly influences the success of the business. With the fundamental knowledge on marketing and branding this module conveys to you, you will have the opportunity to heighten the external image of your equestrian sport business so that it becomes extremely prestigious. You will learn which impact you can make with your altered brand image and how you can thus increase the attractiveness for horse owners, riders, sponsors and dealers. The knowledge gained here, i.e. how to carry out market research and keep an eye on the cost-benefit ratio of marketing measures, will enable you to run your equestrian sport business successfully. The aim is to generate and establish an authentic company image. You will learn which channels you can use to communicate successful marketing to generate in particular sponsors.



Strategic Stable Planning

Executive Track Module

In the final module of the track, which will teach you the most important aspects of strategic management, you will gain an extensive insight into how you can successfully push your equestrian sport business forward as a whole. Good and carefully planned strategic management in an equestrian yard contributes towards increasing the viability of your business, improving your competitiveness and ensuring long-term growth. This involves careful analysis, the establishment of clear goals, the selection of the right strategy as well as checking and monitoring the implementation so that the needs of the business are always satisfied. You have now already successfully completed the other modules and have gained a detailed overview of all relevant themes to get started as a stable manager. The only thing that is missing is knowing how to combine this know-how and implement and guarantee the right strategy.



Mid-term Highlight: CHIO Aachen

This special on-site-event will take place at one of the most well-known showgrounds in the equestrian world, the CHIO Aachen. During the stay participants will have the opportunity to experience the Aachen atmosphere at the World Equestrian Festival.

Our participants get the unique opportunity to network with international experts from the CHIO Aachen. Moreover, this occasion gives them the chance to expand the scope of their business, get to know possible future employers, share their knowledge and expertise and get to know other participants of the program.

During the stay in Aachen, there will also be workshops and courses at the renowned RWTH Aachen University. Afterwards the participants will have the chance to discuss management concerns with long-time experts in this area of expertise.

After this on-site-event the participants from both tracks will either start their internship or return home, each with a lot of new contacts, experience and knowledge.



Internship details Operative Track Module

As participants in the Operative Track tend to have gained little working experiences so far, a 6-month internship, which is designed to prepare working life after graduation, is included in the program. On top of the practical experience the participants gain an outstanding network through the integration into the working environment of the international equestrian sport.

After having theoretically learned about basic stable management, horse welfare, performance and transport in the online courses, the practical period is the heart piece of this track. In alignment with the theoretical contents, the participants gain an insight into all different parts and carry out the tasks of a stable manager in one of our high-class partner stables.

We are proud to offer internships throughout Europe and in the USA and more partners will join around the globe. This gives participants the opportunity to go abroad and improve their English skills, the main language in this industry. These valuable experiences prepare future stable managers for handling international shows, as well as managing a multi-cultural team.



Project work Operative Track Module

In the final phase the project work rounds off the Operative Track of the program. By independently working on a specific topic within a limited period of time (approx. 3 months), the participants learn to develop a structured solution to a practical problem. The aim is to transfer the theoretical content from the online course into a concrete challenge in the partner barn, which will be elaborated in this scientific paper. Thematically, the project work can be chosen in the field of management or equestrian sports.

Optimally, the current stable manager can use the results of the work and implement the recommendations for action, thereby further developing the daily operation of the stable.

Application procedure & acceptance

This is how you apply

In order to qualify for our Equestrian Stable Management certificate program, it is initially important that you fulfil certain prerequisites. To qualify for the **Operative Track** we expect you to have a secondary level education and relevant previous (professional) experience (e.g., equestrian sport, side job, amateur). Additionally, you need to have a great passion for horses and show a high reliability.



To apply for the **Executive Track**, a vocational training/degree or studies in a related field or three years of relevant working experience are necessary. On top, you need to have a professional appearance, a great sense of responsibility and a strategic and structured thinking.



If you fulfil all of the requirements, nothing stands in the way of the actual application! **Fill the application form** out on our website including all of your important particulars and send us your cover letter and CV. We will already accept the first applicants at the end of May. The application **deadline is January 15st, 2024.**



After submitting your application online, you will receive a prompt reply from us. We will then invite you to a **personal interview**. Then, after the interview, all going well, you will be accepted as a participant of the Equestrian Stable Management Certificate Program.

Tell us what is motivating you to further educate yourself and take the next step in your career as a Stable Manager. Furthermore, let us know which goals you pursue that you would like to achieve in future as a Stable Manager.

We look forward to receiving a nicely designed CV containing your complete, personal data. It should additionally outline which professional assignments you have carried out in the past and which practical experience you have already gained that is relevant for the Equestrian Stable Management Certificate Program.

Which qualification will I receive and what is it worth?

After successful completion of a one-year course, you will receive an official „Professional Certificate“, issued by RWTH International Academy and the CHIO Aachen CAMPUS.
